Job Description

Title: Sexual Assault Therapist

Reports to: Senior Director of Programs

Summary: The Sexual Assault Therapist provides crisis intervention and counseling services to victims of sexual violence and family/friends of victims (secondary victims).

Duties:

1. Provide direct services to victims of sexual assault and secondary victims via crisis intervention, individual and/or family sessions and support/ therapy groups.
2. Maintain appropriate case documentation on clients.
3. Participate in regular current training on impact of trauma and treatment for sexual assault survivors to advocates, staff, organizations and community groups.
4. Provide current training on impact of trauma and treatment for sexual assault survivors to advocates, staff, organizations and community groups.
5. Collect statistical data and report on activities as needed.
6. Provide coverage for hotline as needed.
7. Other duties as assigned.

Job Requirements:

1. Skilled in performing counseling and crisis intervention services, especially for treatment of traumatized crime victims.
2. Ability to develop and maintain positive and professional working relationships with clients, staff and community contacts.
3. Must complete 40 hours of mandated OAG sexual assault training.
4. Bilingual English/Spanish highly preferred.

Background:

- A Master's Degree from an accredited college or university in counseling or social work is required.
- Current licensure (or eligibility for licensure) in Texas as LPC-A, LPC, LMSW, LCSW or equivalent is strongly preferred
