Title: Prevention Educator

Reports to: Community Outreach and Education Manager

Summary: The Prevention Educator will assist in delivering the agency's primary prevention school-based curriculum to area schools and other youth organizations as needed.

Duties:

1. Present primary prevention education curriculum at area schools from 6th grade to high school or other youth organization settings.
2. Collect data and pre/post tests from classes as needed.
3. Assist Primary Prevention Coordinator with scoring and tabulating education data and administrative duties as needed.
4. Maintain required documentation for presentations and time sheets.
5. Other duties as assigned.

Job Requirements:

1. Knowledge of issues related to sexual violence prevention.
2. Excellent public speaking, writing and organizational skills.
3. Ability to develop and maintain positive and professional working relationships with volunteers, staff and others in the community.
4. Prior experience teaching or working with youth
5. Ability to use a PC and all applicable software.
